

Criminal Debt Payments via Pay.gov

Summary:

Debtors may make payments towards their criminal debt on-line using Pay.gov. Pay.gov is a secure government website that allows you to submit payments for your federal debt(s) electronically. Pay.gov is managed by the Department of Treasury, Financial Management Services. CVB Payments are not allowed through Pay.gov. Please contact CVB at (800) 827-2982.

Procedures:

1. Visit (GAS Pay.gov web address)
2. To access the form, click on the Continue to the Form button.

NOTE: A Pay.gov account is not required to make a one-time payment. However, debtors may consider obtaining an account for future payments. The advantages of a Pay.gov account include: 1) stored payment information; 2) manage payments; and 3) view payment history.

3. Complete the *Criminal Debt Payment* form. All fields must be completed. To locate your case number, refer to your Debtor Statement or Payment Coupon. If you are unable to locate your court number, please contact the Clerk's Office of the U.S. District Court at (912) 650-4037 for further assistance.


